SECTION 4: First-aid measures

4.1 Description of necessary first-aid measures

General advice Call a physician immediately.

If inhaled Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing.

In case of skin contact Rinse skin with water/shower. Remove/Take off immediately all

irritation or rash occurs: Get medical advice/attention.

In case of eye contact Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if

Irritation. May cause an allergic skin reaction.
